Describe local hospitals and how they have changed over time. <p><u>Florence Nightingale</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Born 12th May 1820 in Italy ~ 200th birthday this year! Became a nurse against her parents' wishes. She treated soldiers during the Crimean War. She was known as the 'lady with the lamp'. She changed the way hospitals were run ~ during the Crimean War and upon her return to England. <p><u>Mary Seacole</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Born in Jamaica 23rd November 1805. Became a nurse using herbal remedies. British Government would not allow her to treat soldiers in the Crimean War so she travelled there herself. She set up a 'British Hotel' hospital where soldiers could receive food, drink and treatment. She went to the front line to treat soldiers from both sides Known as Mother Seacole. <p><u>Edith Cavell</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Born 4 December 1865 Nurse during WW1 ~ treated soldiers from both sides of the war.
