

School Uniform

All children at St. Paul's are expected to wear uniform. We believe that a uniform looks smart, wears well and contributes to a feeling of belonging to the school. We are very proud of our school badge which has historic links with the Church. Our uniform consists of:

Nursery class

We ask children to wear our gold school sweat shirt or cardigan with school badge
(A pair of Wellington boots is needed, to be kept in school for outdoor activities)

Key Stage 1 (Years R, 1 and 2) uniform will be:-

Optional school tie (gold/black)

Black/grey trousers or joggers

Black/grey skirt or pinafore dress

Gold sweatshirt or cardigan with school badge

Long or short sleeved gold polo-shirt or a white school shirt

Dark flat shoes (not trainers)

Black or white plain socks, black tights

Yellow and white summer dresses-knee length, any style, check or stripe

Black/grey shorts/culottes in summer (if desired)

Black fleece jacket

Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5, 6) uniform will be:-

Black/grey trousers (no joggers)

Black/grey skirt - straight or pleated, knee length

Black sweater (V-neck/crew-neck), with school badge

Black cardigan, with school badge

School tie (gold/black)

White shirt/blouse (short sleeved in summer, if preferred)

Black or white plain socks, black tights

Black flat shoes (not trainers)

Yellow/white summer dress, knee length, any style, check or stripe

Black/grey school shorts/culottes in summer, if desired

Black fleece jacket

PE / sports kit – children will need both an outdoor and indoor PE kit

Indoor

- Plain black shorts/PE skirt/black leotard
- Plain white or yellow short sleeved T-shirt
- Black indoor pumps

***These items should be kept at school in a simple drawstring bag. (Yellow St. Paul's drawstring bags are available from school).*

Outdoor

As above but in addition:-

- Trainers for outdoors
- Plain black track suits or sweat tops for cold weather (Optional)

***These items should be brought into school on the appropriate days*

Please make sure that all your child's clothing is named as so many items look the same.

This is particularly true of pumps and wellingtons. Children coming to school in wellingtons or boots must be provided with shoes to change into.

All items of our uniform are available from the 'Schoolwear Centre' in Nuneaton. Free vouchers of £25 per child are available for children who are eligible for FREE SCHOOL MEALS – Please complete the form in the pack and return to the school office.

Ties, book bags, hats and PE bags will continue to be available from the school office.

Jewellery and Valuables

Please make sure that your child leaves watches and jewellery at home. If they have pierced ears, small studs should be worn as other types of ear-ring can be dangerous. All other forms of face and body piercing e.g. Nose studs are not permitted.

****Please note that during PE / games or swimming lessons children are not allowed to wear ear-rings of any kind. Hair that is shoulder length or longer should be tied back and finger nails should be kept short to avoid injury to both themselves and others.**

Mobile phones, toys and other valuable items should not be brought to school. Occasionally the class teacher may request that toys be brought into school (e.g. for topic work).

The school is unable to take responsibility for any of the above items that get lost or broken.
