Dear Parents and Carers,

We are really looking forward to welcoming back your children on Monday 29th June 2020.

As I have said previously, the school will be open Monday, Tuesday or Thursday and Friday for reception and Year 1 children.

In order to make this return as safe as possible there are a number of challenges that we have been busily preparing for:

a. Groupings - (Bubbles)

By now you should have received your child's' group. Each group has a maximum of 9 children and will be known as a bubble. (Your child will, at all times, remain in this bubble-this includes break times and lunch. The Bubble will enable us to maintain 2m distancing, as far as we possibly can, both inside and outside of the classroom.

b. Drop off and collection

Children will enter the school via the main playground pedestrian gate and wait on the Key Stage 1 playground. They will then be received by the class teacher/teaching assistant at the KS1 Entrance. Parents are welcome to enter on to the playground but will not be permitted into the building. Social distancing must be adhered to at all times. Each Bubble has a set time to arrive at school and a set time to finish. These times are: -

Bubble **1A**-9.10am drop off Monday and Tuesday  
3.00pm pick up

Bubble **1B**-9.00am drop off Monday and Tuesday  
2.50pm pick up

Bubble **1C**-9.10am drop off Thursday and Friday  
3.00pm pick up

I do have to insist that you arrive and leave the school, promptly, at the allocated times.
