Vocabulary			To know that garden plants are plants that people to choose to grow in their garden. E.g. fuchsia, pansy, sweet pea, sunflower, rose, lavender, iris.
			To know a wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted and cared for as it grows. E.g. dandelion, daisy, buttercup, nettles, ivy, clover, brambles
			To identify and name some common trees. E.g. Cedar, horse chestnut, oak
			To know deciduous trees lose their leaves each year.
			To know evergreen trees keep their leaves throughout the year.
			To know, sort and compare some common fruit and vegetable plants.
			To know and compare some common plants and trees.
