These mature plants may have flowers which then develop into seeds, berries, fruits etc..</p> <p>• To know that seeds and bulbs need to be planted outside at particular times of year and they will germinate and grow at different rates</p> <p>• To know that some plants are better suited to growing in full sun and some grow better in partial or full shade.</p> <p>To know and explain how plants are suited to their habitats.</p>
