3		Why is it hot in Africa?	There are 7 continents and their names. The location of Africa on a map of the world.	A globe shows where there is land and sea on Earth. What and where the Equator is. The equator runs through Africa.
4		Why is it cold at the South Pole?	There are 7 continents and their names. What and where the equator is. The location of the South Pole (Antarctica) on a map of the world.	The South Pole is far away from the equator. It is the coldest place on Earth. The South Pole doesn't get any direct sunlight.

5	How are the North and South Pole different?	The South Pole is the coldest place on Earth. What and where the equator is. Compass directions –NESW.	South Pole (Antarctica) is land covered in ice and surrounded by ocean. North Pole (Arctic) is a frozen ocean. Antarctica is a continent; the Arctic isn't. Antarctica is colder than the Arctic. Humans live in the Arctic but not the Antarctic. Polar bears live in the Arctic; penguins live in Antarctica.
