1	Name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. Name and locate the four countries of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.	Where do I live?	The 7 continents of the world. The continent we live in is Europe. Nuneaton is a town in Warwickshire, England and the area of Nuneaton that we live is Stockingford.	The United Kingdom is made up of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. Great Britain is an island made up of England, Scotland and Wales. An island is a body of land surrounded by water. Identify the UK / GB on maps and globes. Seas surrounding the UK: English Channel, Irish Sea, North Sea, North Atlantic Ocean.
2	Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the oceans studied at this key stage.	Do we all swim in the same ocean?	The North Atlantic Ocean is one of the UK's surrounding seas.	There are 5 oceans in the world: Atlantic Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Indian Ocean, Arctic Ocean, Southern Ocean. Know where the oceans are.
3	Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key physical features.	What is in our ocean? (Physical features)	Name and location of the 5 oceans. Physical features are natural features on the Earth's surface.	Ocean water is salty. Layers of the ocean: sunlight zone, twilight, zone, midnight zone, abyss, trench. The Mariana Trench is the deepest place on Earth. World's longest mountain range is under the ocean: Mid-Atlantic Ridge.
