2		What is the weather and climate like in India?	<p>Some parts of the world are hot and some are cold depending on where they are.</p> <p>What and where the equator is.</p> <p>Africa is hot.</p> <p>South Pole is cold.</p> <p>India's bordering countries and surrounding seas.</p>	<p>Weather is what it's like outside each day.</p> <p>Climate is weather patterns over time.</p> <p>India's seasons: Winter, Pre-monsoon (Summer), Monsoon, Post-monsoon (Autumn).</p> <p>UK's seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter.</p> <p>India has different climates due to its size.</p> <p>UK has one climate.</p> <p>It rains more and is hotter in India than the UK.</p>

(physical features)	<p>Physical features are natural features on the Earth's surface.</p> <p>Types of physical features.</p> <p>Physical features of the 4 countries of the UK.</p>	<p>Physical features of India: it is a peninsula, Thar Desert, Himalayas mountain range, River Ganges, Deccan Plateau, eastern and Western Ghats.</p>

4		<p>What is it like in India? (human features)</p>	<p>Human features are made or built by humans. Types of human features. Human features of the 4 countries of the UK.</p>	<p>India: Population: over 1 billion. Capital city: New Delhi (11 million people). Other major cities: Mumbai, Bangalore, Kolkata, Chennai. Landmarks: Taj Mahal, Lotus Temple, Main religion: Hindu. UK: Population: 67 million. Capital city: London (8.9 million). Other major cities: Manchester, Birmingham, Glasgow, Liverpool. Landmarks: Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, St Paul's Cathedral. Main religion: Christianity.</p>
5		<p>What is it like to live in India?</p>	<p>Festivals and culture in the 4 countries of the UK.</p>	<p>Festivals/Culture: traditional Indian dress, Diwali, Holi, music and dance. Traditional Indian food (rice, lentils, breads and spices).</p>
